- Build positive partnerships with parents and the local community



Making the difference - 'The Barnwell Way'

'The Barnwell Way' is our holistic approach to education, we know that this is highly effective, it is based on three interconnected foci, that work together to provide the conditions, opportunities, challenge and support for a successful education.

The difference at Barnwell is that we focus equally on providing the right conditions and support, developing student character and excellent student outcomes.

At Barnwell we believe in setting high expectations, there is no tension between providing the right conditions to learn and a rigorous and stretching academic education coupled with outstanding wider personal development. We know that when these components work together, they contribute to well educated, and rounded young people who achieve positive outcomes.



Positive relationships:

Relationships are integral to successful learning; this is our starting point and the key to igniting student growth and learning.

'For a person to 'grow' they need an environment that provides them with genuineness, acceptance and empathy. Without these, relationships and healthy personalities will not develop as they should, much like a tree will not grow without sunlight and water'

An absolute strength of Barnwell is the building of strong and positive relationships and understanding between staff and students, acceptance and empathy foster mutual respect and contributes to providing the right conditions for our students to flourish and grow in a safe and positive environment.

We know and understand our children, we use nurture principles to ensure that every child's needs are understood and met.

Student wellbeing is very important to us, throughout the year our pastoral team are there to support all students and ensure that they are happy in school, we work with our student ambassadors to learn and understand the needs and desires of our students. This important work shapes many decisions in school, we actively listen to our students and parents.

Across both campuses we provide consistency and routine, this creates a secure environment where our students know what to expect and what we expect of them. This provides security and a safe environment to take risks, learn from mistakes and grow.

Even though the school is based on two sites, it feels like one school. Pupils benefit from consistent routines and a strong induction programme' (Ofsted 2021)

Forming strong relationships is the first step in ensuring that our students can fulfil their true potential, however this is not enough alone, we also need to foster student growth.

Building character:

Even with the right conditions for learning, children still need motivation, encouragement and reward to be successful, we believe in intrinsic motivation rather than extrinsic, Through **Character Education** our students learn how to intrinsically motivate themselves from the desire to 'do the right thing' rather than needing extrinsic motivation in the form of sanctions or material reward.

We support our students to build self-belief and become socially confident to grow and build character.

'Pupils want to do well in lessons, contributing well to class discussions, showing curiosity in the questions they ask. Pupils listen closely to their teachers in class' (Ofsted 2021)

Our students develop the ability to remain motivated by long term goals, see a link between effort and achievement, overcome and persevere through and learn from setbacks by developing good coping skills.

This in turn ensures that our students are internally driven, self-regulated and not reliant on material reward or enforced compliance.

Learning and habituation of positive moral attributes/virtues, or as we refer to them at Barnwell as characteristics underpin this approach.

We know that students who realise and surpass their individual academic targets have these key characteristics, they have enabled a successful learning journey. Characteristics that we encourage and develop in all of our students, through **Character Education** are to be Passionate, **Respectful**, **Innovative**, **Determined** and **Empathetic** - **PRIDE**

Throughout their schooling **PRIDE** characteristics are highlighted to our students and opportunities to develop them are planned into lessons in order for our students to demonstrate passion, respectfulness, innovation, determination and empathy. We challenge our students every year to earn **PRIDE** recognition, students who consistently show **PRIDE** characteristics are recognised at our annual PRIDE Celebration evenings.

'Through the curriculum, pupils learn the school values of PRIDE. This learning is interwoven with a well-considered curriculum for personal, social, health and economic education' (Ofsted 2021)

Social confidence enables our students to make points and debate robustly and constructively, listening attentively to the views of others, behaving with courtesy and good manners.

Extra-curricular or as we prefer to call it co-curricular opportunities sit alongside our taught curriculum, there is strong provision that is designed to focus on high quality activities across a wide spectrum of different interests. This provides our students with many opportunities to experience and master skills that complement or contrast their taught curriculum.


