A school on an exciting journey of development, Long Wittenham is a member of Ridgeway Education Trust, a successful and thriving multi-academy trust.

The school benefits from specialist teaching in Music, French and Art as well as secondary expertise across the curriculum from Didcot Girls' School and St Birinus School, providing pupils with a truly well-rounded primary education which enables them to discover new passions and interests.

Our Early Years provision ensures children get their time in school off to a flying start – with no more than 15 children in our Reception class, we quickly get to know children's individual strengths and lay the foundations for them to thrive.





BEYOND THE CURRICULUM

Forest School lessons for all year groups help children develop a deep appreciation for the natural world while at the same time building resilience and teamwork.

Children in Year 6 have priority access to the secondary schools in Ridgeway Education Trust, Didcot Girls' School and St Birinus School. Transition visits and extra-curricular opportunities with the secondary schools and links with other primary schools in the Trust create a rich and ambitious provision for our children.

Children develop friendships with children of all ages and backgrounds in our small, supportive village school community.

Community links, including through Ridgeway Education Trust, open doors for children to work collaboratively with those in other primary schools on a range of reading, creative arts and sports projects.



A STRONG COMMUNITY

We value the close links that we develop between parents and staff, working in partnership to enable all children to excel. By joining our weekly celebration assemblies, parents and carers share in the achievements of all our pupils and contribute to the unique community ethos of our school.

Plans are well progressed to move into a bespoke new school site with purpose-built buildings and outdoor facilities designed with sustainability at its heart. This exciting development is part of the village's Community Plan. We expect to move into the new school site in September 2025.
