Academic Success

We are very proud of our academic achievements and indeed the effort and dedication of students to their studies.

Progress and attainment are rigorously tracked in all areas and our students excel in many different ways. Of course, our national benchmark is the Key Stage 2 SATs test; our results have been among the highest in the county over the last 10 years, and are consistently above national average.

The journey through a Middle School is a unique one. The students make exceptional progress over their four-year journey.

The assessment model in place for KS3 focusses on 3 strands;

Acquisition – students understand factual knowledge related to the subject being studied.

Retention – students retain this knowledge and can see how it is related to previous and subsequent new knowledge.

Application – students can apply this knowledge to different situations and issues.

We use a numerical criteria to support our students' journey through secondary education. The priority is retention and retrieval of knowledge.

We have high expectations of all our students and we believe every child has talents which can be nurtured with the right support and encouragement. The size and success of Robert Bloomfield means that we can continue to offer a balanced and modern curriculum which is second-to-none. We have an incredible array of educational visits and guest speakers to help enhance the learning experience.

Our Academy curriculum helps students to achieve high standards and make excellent progress. There are many opportunities built into lessons to secure the need to recall and retrieve previous learning so that knowledge is fully embedded.

The Arts

We are very proud of the arts provision at Robert Bloomfield. Sport & Education

We are proud of both the standards in lessons and the mass participation in enrichment activities at RBA. The school gained Platinum Mark (with Distinction, one of only 100 in the country) Status – a national award that recognises excellence of provision for all kinds of sports opportunities for students across the spectrum (National competitions through to inclusive sports). We have an outstanding reputation for sporting excellence within the region.



The House System

To further strengthen and build on this, we have our House system, which reflects the proud history and culture of Bedfordshire, along with the vision and the values of our Academy. Catering & School Lunches



We run our kitchens on site and source our food locally.

The standard of the food is excellent and we provide the students with a wide

choice, from traditional school meals, jacket potatoes, pasta king, sandwiches, paninis and a salad bar.

We run a breakfast club from 8am and hot and cold snacks are served at breaktime.

We operate a fully cashless payment system (pin numbers) which enables parents to see exactly what their child has purchased as well as topping up their lunch money account online.

Special Educational Needs

It is the policy of the whole school to allow students access to a broad, balanced and relevant curriculum, including the National Curriculum, with each child encouraged, supported and assisted to develop their abilities to the full.

The schools Special Educational Needs department is led by Mrs Booth, SEN Co and Miss Maynard, Lead teacher of SEND. As a school, we fully embrace a child centered approach to our planning and provision, alongside working with other professionals to provide the best opportunities for the child.

Student Support & Pastoral Care

All students are able to access the pastoral hub. On a day to day basis we are here to support students to enable them to feel happy, confident and valued; creating an environment for them to thrive not only academically but also socially as well.

At the core of our pastoral ethos is the desire to develop, promote and maintain student's emotional well-being, giving them the skills and tools necessary to build resilience and meet all of life's challenges.

Our therapy dog, Honey, is fully involved in aspects of school life; she is in school to support students with their social and emotional learning, we are very positive about the affect she has on our students.
