

MPL's Approach to Behaviour

Mount Pleasant Lane believes in a behaviour management approach rooted in high standards, acceptance and a genuine understanding of children's behaviour. Our policy is built on kindness and compassion, with the idea that relationships should be at the heart of behaviour management. Our school culture sets out the ways in which the adoption of relational, restorative approaches to managing behaviour create a safe and happy school for our children to learn in.

Our behaviour strategy aims for all staff to establish unconditional positive regard for all children. As part of our child-centred approach to managing behaviour, we teach children about our three behaviour rules; we are ready, respectful and safe. Children learn about what these rules look like at school and how they can help to regulate, learn from and improve their own behaviour.
