Preston Hedges Primary School: Preston Hedges Primary is where it all started, the original school in Wootton, Northampton that the Trust grew from. After receiving an outstanding Ofsted grading in 2014, we wanted to share our exceptional practice and provide more children locally with the experiences that Preston Hedges children still enjoy today. The school has benefited enormously from other schools joining the Trust and sharing their enthusiasm, ideas and practice with us. Together we learn from and with each other, and as one team provide the very best experiences and outcomes possible for our children. From our inspirational learning spaces, to our encouragement for children to take an inventive approach to solving problems, Fun, Creativity and Achievement is at the heart of the school; where children are provided with enriching learning experiences on a daily basis. Equally, teachers are supported and encouraged to be brave and deliver sessions that create immersive experiences for pupils of all ages.

Parklands Primary has been proud to be part of the Trust since September 2018 and in this relatively short time the Parklands team has rapidly transformed this much-loved school, and the outcomes for pupils, providing them with exceptional experiences and the very best start to their school careers. The Parklands community is hugely supportive, fully embracing the vision of the Trust, working together and following the school's new ethos of Fun, Creativity and Achievement which underpins the creative new curriculum. In 2022 Parklands Primary won Headteacher of the Year and Primary School of the Year at the Northamptonshire Education Awards.



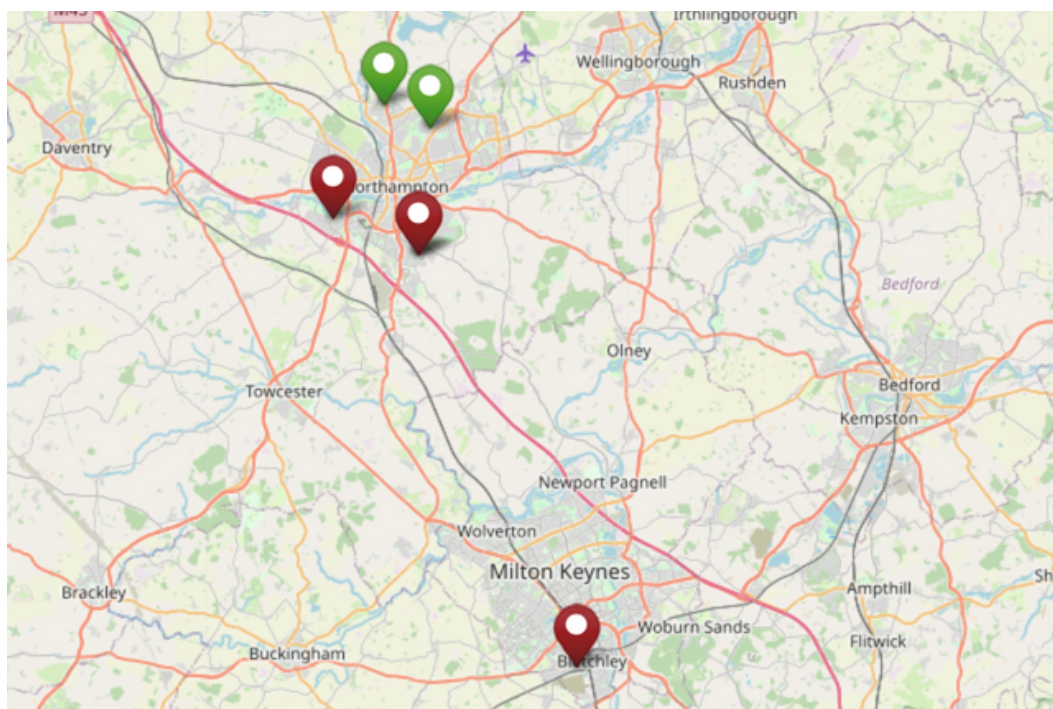
Pineham Barns opened its doors to the community in 2017 as our first Free School. Championing creative and innovative learning experiences, Pineham's bespoke curriculum reflects the needs of our local community and nurtures aspiration, imagination, moral guidance, fun and creativity, alongside academic achievement, giving children the opportunity to develop into compassionate citizens and fulfil their own unique potential. Surrounded by countryside, Pineham's stunning location provides the team with endless inspiration and energy to embed its own interpretation of Fun, Creativity and Achievement. The setting is explored and enjoyed through a creative outdoor curriculum, which brings learning to life and enables all pupils to engage with the outdoors to enhance their learning.





Northampton based Buckton Fields joined the Trust as a brand new two form entry school in September 2021. Proud of its eco credentials, positively contributing to the local area, the school has strong links with neighbouring businesses which enrich and complement the school's creative curriculum and core values. With a focus on sustainability, we learn about and promote how we can be conscious citizens with a love for the world we live in, and take time out for reading and wellness in our underwater themed reading reef. Surrounded by beautiful countryside, we study natural beauty not only on our doorstep, but also in the wider world and celebrate every child as an individual, inspiring children to be passionate, empathetic and resilient in everything they do.

Our first Milton Keynes based school, Holne Chase, is new to the Trust, having joined in December 2020. A proactive member of the local community in Bletchley since opening in 1952, the school is committed to being a school for the whole family, recognising that igniting a love of learning is a partnership between both home and school. Since joining us the team has developed a dynamic, new and engaging curriculum, that fully embraces the ethos of Fun, Creativity and Achievement, whilst also developing a life long love for learning
