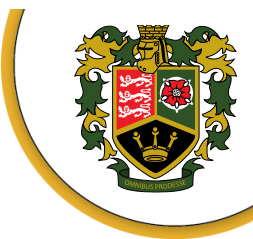

### ECT Induction Programme

Every Early Career Teacher (ECT) at TGAS has access to a robust contextualised induction programme. These fortnightly professional development sessions are in addition to the whole school CPD offer and the EDT blended learning. Each session is facilitated by the induction mentors and a plethora of experienced staff. Further to this, every ECT receives regular protected time to meet with their subject mentor and regular lesson visits with bespoke feedback.

## Facilitating NPQs in conjunction with the TSH

There is a brand-new exciting opportunity to work in collaboration with the TSH to be a part of the **NPQ facilitation team**.

### Why?

Facilitation is one of the best ways to **develop yourself**, and should be seen as an opportunity. Some of the benefits are:

- Delving more deeply into an area of expertise, and developing your own **knowledge**.
- Having your thinking around it challenged, and having opportunities to see things through a **different lens**.
- Working with other colleagues, and **developing your facilitation style** as a result.
- Working with the participants, who will be in settings other than your own, and developing a greater **applied knowledge of your specialism**.
- Seeing other colleagues flourish, and having the satisfaction of knowing that your impact is widening over **other schools and children** that you haven't even met!

### What?

There are slots available to facilitate on all of the above qualifications.

### Time commitment.

We know time is precious, and so we will work with you to support you in delivery. There are two types of role – lead facilitator, and co-facilitator.

Most sessions take place during the school day. Some are online; others are face-to-face, and you may have the opportunity to travel to other settings to deliver there.

## Core CPD

### Instructional Coaching: Collaborative Conversations

All teaching staff will receive **incremental Collaborative Conversations** throughout the academic year. These conversations are a unique way to enhance staff **effectiveness with the Quality First Teaching Framework (QFT)**. The CPD involves a three-step process of consideration of deliberate practice, a lesson visit followed by ring fenced time to discuss deliberate practice. The conversations are **low stakes** and completely focussed on **'betterment'**.

1-In the **Autumn** term every member of staff will have a line manager Collaborative Conversation which has a focus on the School Improvement Plan priority, **formative assessment**. This conversation will organically give a focus to an area of deliberate practice for teachers to purposefully develop over the course of the academic year alongside the continued formative assessment foci. This focus will determine the bespoke engagement with CPD provision.

2-In the **Spring** term every member of staff will complete a department Peer-to-Peer Collaborative Conversation. These conversations will have a clear focus on your identified area of deliberate practice on the QFT Framework following the Autumn cycle and will showcase the engagement with the CPD. Again, this coaching experience is low stakes and completely focussed on 'betterment'.

3-In the **Summer** term every member of staff will complete a second department Peer-to-Peer Collaborative Conversation. These conversations will have a clear focus on your area of deliberate practice following from the Autumn and Spring cycles.
