The Role

We are looking to appoint an efficient and reliable Cleaner to join our team and provide daytime cleaning/janitorial services.

Duties

- Litter picking in and around the school to ensure areas are kept clean and tidy.

- Emptying internal and external rubbish and recycling bins.
- Maintain staff areas (e.g. staff room, staff kitchen) to ensure areas are clean, neat and tidy.
- Replenishing hand towels, toilet rolls and soap dispensers etc. to ensure the facilities are available for use.
- Report any defects or health and safety issues to the Cleaning Supervisor or a member of the Premises Management Team.
- To understand and apply health and safety procedures relevant to the role:

 - First aid & hygiene practice
 - COSHH (Control of Substances Hazardous to Health)
