JOB PURPOSE: The core focus of this job is delivering an efficient food delivery

service operating to the highest standards of food safety. The post holder will do this by carrying out duties such as food preparation, service and other kitchen management duties including the supervision of staff, ordering food, stocktaking and administration, serving meals to children and staff, washing up and cleaning the

kitchen and dining room.
