Katherine Warrington School is a new comprehensive, co-educational and non-denominational academic secondary school (opened September 19) with 750 students currently (180 in each of years 7, 8, 9 and 10 – these year groups are already oversubscribed). The school will add a further 180 students in each subsequent year and then open a 250 strong Sixth Form. By 2025 we will have grown to our capacity of 1,150 students. The school was established through the partnership of the Harpenden Secondary Schools Trust, which includes the three outstanding schools in Harpenden: Roundwood Park, St George's and Sir John Lawes and additional partners: the University of Hertfordshire and Rothamsted Research Centre (a world leading non-profit agricultural science researchcentre).
