

Lunchtime Play Leader

Main Purpose of the Job

Responsible, under the direction of the Head Teacher or other nominated officer, either individually or as part of a team, for securing the safety, welfare and good conduct of pupils during the lunchtime period, in accordance with agreed practices and procedures.

Tasks

- 1. Undertake direct supervision of pupils in designated areas.
- 2. Assist with daily decisions on areas for pupil use, eg: wet lunchtimes.

Resources

1. Be familiar with safe use of outdoor equipment.

Responsibilities

- 1. Supervise conduct of pupils, ensuring safe and orderly conduct within and outside the premises.
- 2. Promote and ensure school rules regarding games allowed are met and that health and safety procedures are maintained.
- 3. Assist pupils in the dining area or playground.
- 4. Deal with minor incidents and where appropriate, refer serious incidents to Senior Lunchtime Co-ordinator or Head Teacher.
 - Clean up spillages or debris around the dining / play areas to ensure the maintenance of good order, discipline and safety.
 - Be aware of and comply with policies and procedures relating to child protection, health, safety and security, confidentiality, reporting all concerns to an appropriate person.
 - Be aware of and support diversity and ensure equal opportunities for all.
 - Contribute to the overall ethos/work/aims of the school.
 - Appreciate and support the role of other professionals.
 - Attend and participate in relevant meetings as required.
 - Participate in training and other learning activities and performance development as required.
- 5. Undertake any other duties commensurate with the level of the post, as required to ensure the efficient and effective running of the Department / Section.
