CASE STUDY: LEAD TEACHER

As a Lead Practitioner, Mark Wright's role is two-fold. Firstly, coordinating the Key Stage 3 and Key Stage 5 English curriculum which involves reading up on the latest information about literary texts, especially with a focus on diversity so that the curriculum is all-encompassing and students develop knowledge and skills that are relevant to the 21st century. Secondly, he provides coaching to colleagues across the academy to empower them to be the best they can be in the classroom.

Working and living in Burnham on Crouch

We can offer an excellent range of facilities as part of your working environment with outstanding specialist rooms, a main hall with tiered seating and lighting/sound control booth, a fully equipped fitness suite and gym, dedicated sixth form centre, performing arts block with two drama studios, a music room and four practice suites; we even have our own onsite Motor Vehicles facility. Our green campus is located on extensive playing fields, with a MUGA, and an all-weather Astroturf pitch with lighting.

Popular but exclusive

To fulfil your work-life balance priorities and to maximise the benefits of your career with us and your life outside of work, Burnham on Crouch and the surrounding area offers a relaxed, calm and peaceful environment. This jewel of the Essex countryside and quaint riverside market town is predominately known for its coastal trading history and sailing activities and has the title of Cowes of the East Coast. There is an abundance of recreational and cultural amenities to get involved in along with sharing the space with the amazing wildlife and the area's infamous family of seals.

The town has a gorgeous marina and is best known as a yachting centre hosting the internationally famous 'Burnham Week' that takes place in August, hence its Cowes title. The area is popular for sailing, fishing and fossil hunting, whilst also enjoyed by bikers, cyclists, twitchers, dog walkers and wildlife enthusiasts. An iconic clocktower dominates the pretty high street with a growing selection of quaint pubs, bars, tearooms and restaurants. There are museums, a cinema, a sports centre and an 18 hole golf club. Annual events draw authors, artists and craftspeople from across the region who regularly display in a variety of media including painting, ceramics, sculpture, photography, jewellery

and textiles. There is a brilliant torchlight carnival, an annual floral event, a weekly street market, monthly farmers' market, a Saturday Parkrun, an annual cycle ride, a triathlon, an art trail and flower shows, and the magical annual traditional Christmas market.

Home is where the heart is

From timber-clad cottages to Georgian brick town houses, fishermen's cottages and Victorian terraces; there is a home to suit everyone's budget. For sale in Burnham and the surrounding area are one-bed flat/apartments from £145k, two-bed flats or established homes from £230k, two-bed new builds starting at £305k and two-bed Victorian terraces from £330k. Looking for more? There are three-bed established homes from £300k, town houses from £450k and detached homes from £450k+. Rental properties in Burnham on Crouch start at around £1,200 pcm for a two-bed apartment but further afield, in places such as Rochford (within a 30-40 minute train/drive), a one-bed flat is around £725pcm and a two-bed from £890pcm.

Sights, sounds and memories

If you are looking for a busier pace of life during some downtime then London is a hop, skip and a jump away with an hour's train journey into Liverpool Street Station (these trains are every 40 minutes) or a direct train service to Southend, our local international airport. Additionally, from Southend Airport there is direct easy access to many European destinations, from Alicante to Palma de Mallorca.

If you have been inspired, we encourage you to come and be part of this unique and special part of the East Coast where a new chapter in your career at Ormiston Rivers Academy will navigate you to adventures and experiences like no other.
