

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Average of grade 5 or higher across all GCSE exams, including a minimum grade 5 for English and Maths.

Subject specific requirements also apply, e.g. grade 7 or higher in GCSE Maths for those wishing to study A Level Maths.





T Levels are the new gold standard in vocational education. Designed by industry experts, students gain practical experience while also achieving qualifications needed to progress to higher education.

T Levels lead to apprenticeships, work or university.

SUPPORT FOR STUDENTS STUDYING T LEVELS INCLUDES:

- Access to the Apprenticeship Support and Knowledge programme.
- Preparation for progressing to higher and degree level apprenticeships.
- Mock interviews with employers.
- A variety of higher education and employer talks during the course.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

A minimum of five GCSE pass grades (4 and above) including English and Maths.

T LEVEL DIGITAL PRODUCTION, DESIGN AND DEVELOPMENT

T LEVEL HEALTH

Prepares students for a career in the digital industries, one of the fastest growing sectors in the UK.

The 16-19 Bursary Fund provides financial support to help students overcome the specific financial barriers they face to remaining in education.


Eligible students may receive financial support to assist with costs linked to their programme of study.
