Role Title: School Crossing Patroller

Accountable to: Head Teacher

Grade: B

Key Purpose of Role

To ensure a safe environment for school children and other pedestrians who use the nominated crossing point at Rickley Park Primary School, in order to minimise risk and reduce collisions and injury.

Work Profile

- Undergoing any and all training required to fulfil the role (MKCC will provide specific SCP training, with the school providing training in relation to the appropriate policies).
- Operating the crossing point in accordance with that training and the Highway Code
- Reporting any incidents that occur at the crossing point in a timely manner (e.g. if a driver ignores the instruction to stop, MKCC should be made aware of any such incidents as soon as possible and may need to speak to the SCP to get further information).
- Wearing the provided uniform at all times while operating the crossing. Ensuring
 that all uniform and equipment is fully functional and regularly checked.
 Reporting faults in a timely manner. (Reports should be made to the school in the
 first instance, but MKCC will replace faulty kit once we have been notified by the
 school)
- Undertaking duties in all weathers, including occasional exposure to extremes of heat and cold.
- Providing road safety awareness skills to children through the reinforcement of road safety messages.
- Liaising and communicating with children and adults of all ages to provide road safety information and advice when appropriate.

<u>PLEASE NOTE</u> that SCPs should <u>NOT</u> be asked or expected to control parent parking. They have neither the training, nor the legal powers to do this. Doing this may cause them to be distracted from their primary role.





Other information
