The North Walsham Way: Trust, Resilience, Excellence and Kindness



Start of the day

- We enter school via the student path and arrive before 8:25am.
- We go directly to our key stage zones.
- We line up in our tutor groups in single file in register order on the sound of the first whistle.
- We are silent by the sound of the second whistle, ready for our learning.
- In the event of inclement weather we follow the same routines in our wet weather zones.

Phones

 Once we enter the school grounds we have our phones switched off and in our bag or placed in our locker.

Tutor time

- We have our uniforms checked every day during line ups.
- We walk to our tutor room purposefully.
- We enter the room and sit in silence.
- We complete the register in silence and respond with Sir or Miss/Ma'am.
- We have our equipment checked every day.
- Equipment consists of: 2 pens; pencil; ruler; rubber; scientific calculator; highlighter; reading book; pencil case; glue stick; knowledge organiser; planner; green pen; home learning booklet (KS3 only).
- All equipment must be in full working order.
- We strive for excellence in all of the tutor time tasks.
- We listen to notices in silence.
- We pack up when instructed by our tutor and stand behind our chairs in silence and wait to be dismissed.

Assemblies

- We enter the assembly in single file and silence.
- We sit in register order and in our house rows.
- $\boldsymbol{\cdot}$ We stand up and collect our rewards in assembly.

<u>Uniform</u>

- We wear correct uniform every day with excellence, including no false nails/nail polish, natural make-up and minimal jewellery (see behaviour for learning policy)
- Correct uniform consists of:
- Black professional school shoes
- Black socks
- o Blazer sleeves rolled down
- o Skirts must be knee length
- o Shirts must be tucked in
- School tie
- Trousers/Tailored Shorts
- We remove our coats as we enter a classroom.
- We ask permission to remove our blazer in lessons.

Transitioning around school

- We walk purposefully to our next lesson.
- We walk on the left in single file.
- We follow the one-way system.
- We behave in a positive manner.
- We greet teachers and visitors.

Lesson arriva

- We enter silently in single file and get out our equipment and student planner.
- We sit down and complete the 'Do Now' task in silence.
- We complete the register in silence and respond with Sir or Miss/Ma'am.

Our classroom expectations

- We follow all instructions immediately.
- We complete our work to the best of our ability.
- We strive for excellence.
- We make every minute count.
- We are cognitively active at all times.
- We sit up straight, face the front, with our knees under the desk.
- We listen attentively.
- We speak in full sentences, using the appropriate form and register.
- We ask questions relevant to our learning.
- We do not interrupt whoever is speaking.
- We do not disrupt the learning of others.
- We always act on and respond to the feedback we receive every lesson.
- We sit where our teacher chooses.

Consequences

We can be given consequences for any behaviour that interrupts learning. For example:

- Not striving for excellence, for example:
- Not attempting all questions on the Do Now.
- Not completing work to the best of our ability.
- Not attempting or providing an answer when cold called.
- Not answering in full sentences using appropriate form and register.
- Distracting other pupils, for example:
- Tapping equipment when someone is talking.
- Talking during silent times.
- Unauthorised lateness.
- Talking when others are talking.
- Leaving a chair without permission.
- Not following instructions.
- o Challenging consequences.
- We accept the consequences given by our teachers.

C1

- Opportunity to alter behaviour.
- Name written on white board.

C2

- 20 minute detention given (to be sat at the nearest opportunity; lunch or after school).
- Name written on white board indicating C2

C3

- Removed from the lesson.
- 40 minute detention given (to be sat at the nearest opportunity; lunch or after school).
- We understand if we gain 60 minutes of detentions in a day we will be placed into internal exclusion.

Instant Removal

- Removed due to extreme behaviour and placed into internal exclusion.
- Further sanctions to follow removal.

Automatic C2

- Chewing gum
- Graffiti on body or in books
- Swearing

Detentions

- We turn up when expected.
- We enter in silence and sit where instructed.
- We serve our full detention time.
- We complete our assigned detention tasks.
- We understand that failure to attend a detention will result in further consequences.

Rewards

- We strive for excellence and demonstrate our values to receive merits and Golden Tickets.
- We celebrate the successes of ourselves and our neers.
- We stand up and collect our rewards in assembly.
- We aim to complete the TREK award each year.

Lesson departure

- We pack up when instructed, stand behind our chairs in silence and wait to be dismissed.

Break time

- We eat our food in our key stage zones.
- We place our litter in the bins provided.
- On the sound of the first whistle we line up in our tutor groups in single file and register order.
- We are silent by the sound of the second whistle, ready for our learning.

Lunchtime

- We collect our food at the designated time.
- We eat sat down in the canteen.
- We ensure our area is clean and tidy before we leave.
- We do not leave the canteen until instructed to changeover.
- We use the library for library sanctioned activities.
- We line up in our tutor groups in single file and register order on the sound of the first whistle.
- We will be silent on the sound of the second

Bullying/Unkindness

- We are upstanders not bystanders.
- We all have #ZeroTolerance towards bullying and unkindness.

Toilets

- We use toilets for their intended purposes.
- We enter cubicles on our own.
- If we are in KS3 we use the English or Science
- If we are in KS4 we use the upstairs Atrium or
- Science toilets.
 We do not use toilets in lessons, unless there is an emergency.

- We wait on the pavement for buses in an orderly fashion.
