Wolfreton is a large and forward-thinking school. We are an ambitious community, and we recognise the impact of our exceptional staff on the development of a positive and engaged student body. Working together it is our vision that we can be a place where everyone can, 'Achieve their ambitions'.

Wolfreton is part of The Consortium Academy Trust. Our Trust supports almost 8,000 children and young people aged 3 to 18, working to ensure an excellent education and learning experience is provided for each and every child and young person.

We are a large, truly comprehensive school with over 1500 students on roll, including over 200 in the Sixth Form. We are a good and successful school as a result of our dedicated and talented staff, our engaged and engaging student body and our valued partnerships with parents, carers and the wide range of other stakeholders with whom we collaborate. We are however ambitious for more. Motivated by our Vision and Values, we aspire for great things so we can impact further on the life experiences and life chances of all our people.

The school is set in the attractive leafy suburbs of the East Riding of Yorkshire close to the Wolds and only seven miles from the market town of Beverley. The catchment area covers the pleasant residential districts of Willerby, Kirk Ella and Anlaby in the East Riding of Yorkshire. These are relatively affluent areas with good quality housing and access to varied leisure opportunities. Proximity to the M62 ensures easy access to the motorway network and other major cities in Yorkshire and beyond.

Historically, Wolfreton was a split-site school however, in 2016 we took possession of our new single site school. Staff and students alike are now enjoying the benefits of highquality accommodation, equipped with the latest technology and specialist facilities that are amongst the best in the region. At Wolfreton students and staff enjoy the benefits that being part of a large school affords them. Pastorally, we operate a year group structure, with Heads of Year and Pastoral Managers leading our tutor teams to ensure that all students are known as individuals. Alongside this, our Houses remain, providing the opportunity for competition, charity work and more – we believe that through further development of these important areas we will continue to impact positively on the post-pandemic world. Our staff also benefit from the opportunities that come with being part of a large team. Faculties and support staff teams are supported to develop and collaborate. We believe in the value of continuous engagement in learning and development for all and being part of a large school team and our Trust team enables this.

Academically, our curriculum vision is to, 'Ignite Fires and Expand Horizons' so our students can 'Achieve their Ambitions'.
