Introduction and School Context:

Wixams Academy opened in September 2017 to 120 Year 7 students. Bedford College Academies Trust (BCAT) is seeking to appoint exceptional teachers to grow the talented opening staff team at the Academy. This is the first of a number of advertisements for positions at the Academy this year.

Wixams is one of the most rapidly growing developments in the southern region, straddling the boundary of Central Bedfordshire and Bedford Borough, and is characterised by beautiful open countryside, lakes, and an aspirational and vibrant close-knit community. Sitting just south of Bedford it has grown to 1,400 homes, with 4,000 more planned for the development.

At capacity, Wixams Academy will be a Year 7-13 secondary school and sixth form, for 825 students. The Academy will grow steadily with at least one new year group starting per year. The new Academy building is now fully open and operational, affording us excellent state-of-the-art facilities throughout.

We work closely with local primary schools including Lakeview, Wilstead and the new Wixams Tree Primary. Our collective aim is to create an outstanding educational offer for local families.

Both Wixams Academy and Wixams Tree Primary next door are run by BCAT and this unique campus arrangement will provide numerous opportunities and benefits to the pupils and staff in both schools.

Overall purpose:

To be responsible for the learning and achievement of all students in allocated classes, ensuring equality of opportunity for all.

To be responsible and accountable for achieving the highest possible standards in students' learning, work and conduct.

Main Duties

1. Leadership and Management of Staff

- Work collaboratively with other members of the Academy's teaching team and provide leadership and support where appropriate.
- Effectively deploy and supervise the work of Learning Support Assistants assigned to classes.

2. Management of Resources

- Take a role in the preparation and development of teaching materials and teaching programmes as appropriate
- Ensure that these curriculum plans are differentiated to meet the needs of all students

3. Teaching and Learning

- Ensure there is a high quality climate for learning within lessons and promote the values of the Academy
- Promote high expectations of student progress and attainment
